

### **Bereavement Services – Update noted.**

**3** There was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability providing an update on the current status of the Bereavement Service, advising

- (1) of the delivery by the Council's Bereavement Services team administered from Daldowie Crematorium and the statutory legislation in place to govern the cremation, interment and memorial inspection process;
- (2) that the Council had responsibility for 32 cemeteries and churchyards of which 8 were under regular use and along with 2 crematoria, Linn and Daldowie, and undertook an average of 5500 cremations and 1000 burials per year across the city;
- (3) of the regulations in place for cremation and burial grounds;
- (4) of the Council's service delivery, cemetery capacity and headstone/memorial/wall inspections with burial grounds;
- (5) that the HM Senior Inspector of Burial, Cremation and Funeral Directors carried out annual inspections and administrative process audits, the most recent having been carried out in March 2022; and
- (6) that in conjunction with Daldowie Training Centre, Linn and Daldowie Crematoria had been registered as a training centre.
