

Glasgow Food Growing Strategy and Action Plan – Update noted.

2 With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 1st February 2022 (Print 6, page 442) noting an updated Glasgow Food Growing Strategy (FGS) and Action Plan, there was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability providing a further update on the FGS and Action Plan, advising

- (1) of the FGS 16 high level actions to assist the city to deliver more growing spaces and support more growers in the city along with key developments and the reasonable steps taken to provide sufficient allotments as detailed in Appendix III of the report;
- (2) in further detail in relation to waiting lists as detailed in Appendix I of the report;
- (3) of the FGS themes including the growing spaces to be delivered, sources of information and engagement; and
- (4) that in terms of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015 each local authority would prepare and publish an annual allotments report and that this would be presented to this committee for consideration prior to submission to the Scottish Government as detailed in Appendix II of the report.
