## Sustainable Procurement Strategy 2023-27 approved.

- With reference to the minutes of the Wellbeing, Equalities, Communities, Culture and Engagement City Policy Committee of 2nd March 2023 (Print 6, page 613) when it was agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the Sustainable Procurement Strategy 2023-27, Councillor Kelly, Convener for Neighbourhood Services and Assets, presented the strategy, advising
- (1) that the strategy had been developed, as required by section 15 of the Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014, to support the Council's challenges, missions and commitments, as set out in the Council's Strategic Plan 2022-27;
- that the development of the strategy had been taken forward by a short-term cross party working group, which comprised of representatives across all groups and had been chaired by the Chair of the Contracts and Property Committee, with support from the Head of Corporate Procurement and the Head of Commissioning, Social Work Services;
- (3) that the development of the strategy had been informed by 2 consultations, with the first seeking feedback regarding the delivery and performance of the Corporate Procurement and Commercial Improvement Strategy 2018-22 and the second seeking comments from Glasgow citizens via a consultation hub on the proposed vision, mission, key objectives and supporting actions of the strategy;
- (4) that the strategy set out the vision, objectives and actions which would direct and govern procurement activities for this Council for 2023-27 and focused on 6 key strategic objectives, as detailed in the report; and
- (5) of the governance and performance reporting arrangements for the strategy.

After consideration, the committee approved the Sustainable Procurement Strategy 2023-27.
