

Glasgow's Draft Local Housing Strategy 2023-28 – Preparation and consultation noted.

2 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding Glasgow's Draft Local Housing Strategy (LHS) 2023-28, advising

- (1) that local authorities were required under the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 to prepare a LHS supported by an assessment of housing need and demand and in March 2021, the Scottish Government had published its long-term housing strategy, Housing to 2040 which set out 4 themes, priorities and 20 key actions with associated sub-actions, all which had been considered and informed Glasgow's Draft LHS 2023-28;
- (2) of the preparation for Glasgow's Draft LHS 2023-28;
- (3) that Glasgow's Draft LHS 2023-28, as detailed in an Appendix to the report built on the progress made through the 2017-22 strategy and was an ambitious strategy which set out how the Council wanted homes and communities to look and feel like in Glasgow over the next 5 years and beyond and proposed 5 LHS priorities and 14 missions; and
- (4) that a smart survey for Glasgow's consultative draft LHS 2023-28 would be published on the Council's consultative hub and alongside the main survey, a detailed programme of LHS consultation would be undertaken between January and April 2023 and once completed, the strategy would be finalised for approval by the City Administration Committee.

After consideration and having heard a presentation by Ms Jennifer Sheddan, Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, the committee noted

- (a) the presentation and thanked Ms Sheddan for her contributions;
- (b) the draft Local Housing Strategy 2023-28;
- (c) plans for consultation and engagement; and
- (d) plans for finalising the strategy.
