

Glasgow's Transformational Regeneration Area programme – 10-year anniversary update noted.

7 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding Glasgow's Transformational Regeneration Area programme, advising

- (1) that the 10-year anniversary to establish Glasgow's Transformational Regeneration Area (TRA) programme was marked during April 2022 and that the programme was being delivered through a strategic partnership known as Transforming Communities: Glasgow (TC:G) who oversaw delivery of a regeneration programme across the TRAs;
- (2) of the progress and key achievements in delivering regeneration projects across the TRA programme, as detailed in the report;
- (3) of the future activities that would be progressed going forward by TC:G including housing projects that had either been completed or scheduled to be completed between 2022/23 and 2023/24 as part of the TRA programme;
- (4) of stakeholder, tenant and community engagement that would be delivered; and
- (5) that the 8 TRAs would continue to feature as key regeneration priorities in the Council's forthcoming Strategic Housing Investment Plan which would relate to the 5-year period between 2024/25 and 2028/29, with the plan including specific references to future phases of affordable housing development across the TRA programme and that the plan would be submitted to the City Administration Committee during October 2023 for consideration.

After consideration, the committee noted

- (a) the progress by Transforming Communities: Glasgow to deliver the Transformational Regeneration Area Programme including key highlights/milestones; and
- (b) the future housing regeneration programme that Transforming Communities: Glasgow would work towards delivering going forward.
