

## **Parks lighting review – Update noted.**

**6** With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 22nd November 2022 (Print 4, page 468) noting an update on the parks lighting engagement process undertaken and the intended next steps, there was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability providing an update on the Parks Lighting Review following conclusion of the consultation process, advising

- (1) of the considerations taken into account into and an evidence-led approach to lighting solutions within the city's parks that could be viewed holistically and as part of a place-based approach;
- (2) of the community and stakeholder engagement undertaken with a wide range of partners and parks user groups to ensure all views were heard and incorporated where possible;
- (3) of the Glasgow Parks Safety and Lighting Placemaking Project Report by Greenspace Scotland that outlined the potential measures from the engagement process that could be actioned by a range of organisations, including Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability, into short, medium and long term actions, as detailed in Appendix 1 of the report;
- (4) of the tasks highlighted within the engagement process that would be addressed through existing resources and revenue budgets outwith the bird nesting season and prior to October 2023; and
- (5) of the next steps.
