Thriving Glasgow City Portrait definitions approved.

- With reference to the minutes of the Net Zero and Climate Progress
 Monitoring City Policy Committee of 8th August 2023 (Print 3, page 68) when it had
 been agreed to recommend to this committee approval of the Thriving Glasgow City
 Portrait definitions, Councillor Millar, City Convener for Climate, Glasgow Green
 Deal, Transport and City Centre Recovery, presented a report regarding the matter,
 advising
- (1) that during COP26, the Council had made a political commitment to become a Thriving City and, to progress this work, Glasgow had committed to working with C40, who were a global network of mayors from the world's leading cities that were united in action to address the climate crisis;
- (2) that the Thriving Cities Initiative (TCI) was a key programme of work led by C40, to address those issues and TCI used an iterative approach to support cities in addressing unsustainable consumption to help achieve the targets of the Paris Agreement and improve equity, quality of life and economic livelihoods in cities and Glasgow, through its hosting of COP26 and its work in addressing the climate and ecological emergency, had been invited to be part of this work;
- (3) of the primary aims and goals and work completed to date on the TCI which included the development of the Thriving Glasgow City Portrait (TGCP), led by the Gallant team at the University of Glasgow, together with the thriving definitions that made up the TGCP, as outlined in an appendix to the report; and
- (4) of the outputs and next steps, as detailed in the report.

After consideration, the committee approved the Thriving Glasgow City Portrait definitions.
