

NORTH EAST SECTOR COMMUNITY PLANNING PARTNERSHIP'S MINUTES.

Minutes of meeting held by video conference on 24th November 2021

Minutes of previous meeting approved.

1 There was submitted and approved the minutes of 25th August 2021, the Partnership having noted in relation to paragraph 1 of those minutes that Michaela Collins, Glasgow Third Sector Interface Network had provided an update from her conversations with representatives from Social Recovery Task Force advising that

- (1) the draft Better Relationships, Better Outcomes report had received overwhelmingly positive feedback from both third and public sector, as well as politicians across the political spectrum and the report in its current format would be promoted to the main political parties to seek endorsement for the approach it sets out as part of the development of party manifestos for the 2022 local authority elections;
- (2) at an officer level, Glasgow City Council's Corporate Management Team had nominated 6 senior officers to join a working group alongside 6 representatives from the third sector, with the group being jointly chaired by Ian Bruce, Chief Executive of Glasgow Council for the Voluntary Sector, and Bernadette Monaghan, Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities in Glasgow City Council; and
- (3) the purpose of that group was to agree an implementation plan based on the recommendations from the report and the group would meet every 6 weeks and would provide regular updates to the Community Planning Partnership.

Glasgow Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework - Membership update noted.

2 There was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Legal and Administration providing an update on the membership of this Partnership, advising

- (1) that Jimmy Wilson and Michaela Collins were now the representative and substitute representative respectively for Glasgow Third Sector Interface Network; and
- (2) of the current membership of the Partnership, as detailed in the report.

Glasgow Transport Strategy – Consultation on draft policy framework – Presentation noted.

3 There was heard a presentation by D Paton, Group Manager, Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability on the Glasgow Transport Strategy draft policy framework, which was currently out for consultation and discussion.

After consideration, the Partnership noted the presentation and thanked Ms Paton for her contribution.

Social Recovery Task Force – Update noted.

4 There was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities providing an update on the work of the Social Recovery Taskforce,

- (1) advising that
 - (a) the Task Force had now produced high-level guidance for a refreshed Community Action Plan for Glasgow Community Planning Partnership (GCCP) and the last meeting of the Task Force would be in December 2021; and
 - (b) the draft Community Action Plan would be submitted to the GCCP Strategic Partnership on 7th December 2021 and would be taken forward in 3 phases, as detailed in the report; and
- (2) detailing in the appendix to the report, a summary of the current position in relation to the workstreams, as well as the reports that had been presented to each meeting of the task force.

Glasgow Communities Fund – Update noted etc.

5 With reference to the minutes of 25th August 2021 when the Partnership noted an update on the Glasgow Communities Fund and that a further update would be submitted to this meeting, there was submitted and noted a report by the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities regarding the current position in relation to the Fund, advising that

- (1) the Council's Wellbeing, Empowerment, Community and Citizen Engagement (WECCE) City Policy Committee had been considering a review of the Glasgow Communities Fund and as part of the review Ipsos MORI had been commissioned to carry out research with the Third Sector; and
- (2) on 11th November 2021 the WECCE City Policy Committee had considered an update on the review and had:-
 - (a) noted the report together with the research findings from Ipsos MORI following consultation with the Third Sector and the responses to the consultation and recommendations; and
 - (b) agreed
 - (i) to establish a short-life working group, chaired by Councillor Layden, to help shape the next phase of the GCF and that the membership of the group comprise of elected members and the Third Sector, with a nomination being submitted from each political group on that committee and a minimum of 6 representatives from the Third Sector, ensuring that half of the Third Sector representatives should have experience of direct service delivery and that at least 1 should be from an equalities organisation; and
 - (ii) having heard concerns from members regarding the viability of the draft timetable for phase 2 of the GCF, that further consideration be given to the timescales detailed prior to a further report being submitted to the City Administration Committee as soon as possible and instructed the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities to make the necessary arrangements.

Scottish Fire and Rescue Service - Ward update noted etc.

6 There was submitted and noted a report by the Station Manager, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) advising the Partnership of the current issues, incidents and work being carried out in the North East Sector during the period from 1st July to 30th September 2021.

Minutes of Glasgow Community Planning Strategic Partnership noted.

7 The minutes of the Glasgow Community Planning Strategic Partnership of 7th September 2021 were submitted and noted.
