

Community Justice Glasgow Annual Report 2020/21 noted.

3 There was submitted a report by the Director of Community Empowerment and Equalities regarding the Community Justice Glasgow (CJG) Annual Report for 2020/21, advising

- (1) that the annual report was required to fulfil 1 of CJG's statutory responsibilities under section 23 of the Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016 and that the report would form part of the data set from which Community Justice Scotland would draw information to compile its own annual report, which would be laid before the Scottish Parliament;
- (2) that the annual report reflected the strength and flexibility of the Community Justice Partnership in Glasgow, with the fully searchable and interactive digital report showcasing just some of the achievements that had been made through collaboration, co-production and engagement across the organisations and services involved and provided an opportunity to formally check progress against those aims and objectives that partners had agreed to focus on as part of the outcome improvement performance reporting;
- (3) that as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, much of the information that was relied upon locally and nationally had not yet been published and that this had meant that from a data standpoint, CJG was unable to show a coherent picture that demonstrated progress towards performance outcomes but that the performance section of the annual report would be updated as data became available;
- (4) that vulnerability of performance reporting had been a well-documented weakness in the current National Performance Framework, with the said Framework and the National Strategy for Community Justice currently being refreshed and out for consultation;
- (5) of the content and concept of the digital annual report and that the feedback from last year's first digital newspaper style annual report had been extremely positive; and
- (6) of the launch of the annual report at a livestream event entitled "Let's Talk about Community Justice" on 28th October 2021 and that over the course of the remainder of 2022 the annual report would be used as a key engagement, communication and discussion tool.
