Glasgow's Climate Adaptation plan approved.

- 10 With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 15th March 2022 (Print 7, page 534) when it was agreed to recommend to this committee approval of Glasgow's Climate Adaptation plan, Councillor Millar, Convener for Climate, Glasgow Green Deal, Transport and City Centre Recovery, presented a report regarding The Plan, advising
- (1) that The Plan was a key step to address the climate and ecological emergency and set an ambitious target for the city of Glasgow to achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2030;
- (2) that The Plan was a commitment under action 19 of the Climate Plan and would prepare the city to become climate ready and resilient towards any further and projected climate impacts;
- (3) of the climate impacts that affected Scotland and that it was vital that Glasgow build its climate resilience and capacity by adapting early and effectively to the impacts of climate change and The Plan had been developed based on analysis of key documents outlining current and projected climate impacts as well as local assessments undertaken in collaboration with a range of city stakeholders; and
- (4) of the key risks for the city, the proposed adaptation intervention and actions as detailed in the appendix to the report.

After consideration, the committee approved the adoption of the Climate Adaptation Plan.
