Food growing space, over and above those set out within the above, occupied, or scheduled to complete, since *Part 9 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015 – Allotments Guidance for Local Authorities* was published in June 2019), can be summarised as follows:

Ward 1 – Linn

14 additional entry level plots at Croftburn Allotments bringing an additional 370m² (0.037 ha) into productive use- completed 2021/22.

Ward 2 – Newlands/ Auldburn

22 additional plots at Mansewood Allotments, improved accessibility and 8 accessible raised bed and an orchard bringing an additional 1800m² (0.18 ha) into productive use, completed 2021/22.

Ward 6 – Pollokshields

Social enterprise leasing the 22000m² (2.2 ha) former plant nursery in Bellahouston Park with site occupancy commencing 2019/20.

Ward 7 – Langside

New growing spaces being developed at the former changing rooms in Queens Park Recreation Ground 4600m² (0.46 ha), with site occupancy commencing 2020/21.

Ward 10- Anderston City/Yorkhill

47 raised beds to be sited within the new, expanded site 1,221m² (0.12 ha) for Greyfriars Garden, scheduled for completion 2022/23.

Ward 14- Drumchapel/Anniesland

36 plots, event space, outdoor education space, sitooterie, polytunnel, wildflower/biodiversity area and an orchard at the 6000m² (0.6 ha) Growchapel Phase 1- completed 2021/22.

Ward 22- Dennistoun

20 plots within the 2244m² (0.22 ha) Sighthill allotments scheduled for completion towards the end of the 2021/22 financial year.
