

National Park City – Update noted – Recommendation to City Administration Committee.

10 There was submitted and noted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding the campaign for Glasgow to be declared a National Park City, advising

- (1) that the concept of a National Park City was to inspire a shared vision for greener, healthier, and wilder cities where people, places and nature were better connected and a Glasgow National Park City campaign group had been formed and had made initial contact with Glasgow City Council as detailed at Appendix 1 of the report;
- (2) of the aims of the Glasgow National Park City campaign group and the development of those aims, the application process, the links to existing Council strategy and workplace and the implications for the Council of endorsement to the National Park City foundation;
- (3) of the next steps.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) agreed to recommend to the City Administration Committee the recommendation that the Council becomes a supporter of the National Park City Campaign.
