Circular economy route map etc – Update noted.

- With reference to the minutes of the City Administration Committee of 3rd December 2020 (Print 4, page 206) approving the Circular Economy Route Map and Action Plan, there was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods and Sustainability providing the progress made to delivery of the action plan on the Circular Economy Route Map, advising
- (1) that a wide scale consultation had been undertaken to identify stakeholders to play a pivotal role in the development and implementation of the circular economy in the city carried out in collaboration with the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), the Glasgow Chamber of Commerce and Zero Waste Scotland and these interviews had helped shape the OECD document "Case Study on the Circular Economy in Glasgow" which was launched on 11th November 2021 during the UN COP26 Climate Conference;
- (2) of the route map's 10-year vision;
- (3) of the significant progress undertaken across the 6-themed Action Plan as detailed at Appendix 1 of the report; and
- (4) of the next steps.

After consideration, the committee

- (a) noted the report and that further updates would be provided on an annual basis; and
- (b) agreed to continue to support the work of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability in promoting the transition to a citywide circular economy.
