

## **Supporter of National Park City Campaign approved.**

**5** With reference to the minutes of the Environment, Sustainability and Carbon Reduction City Policy Committee of 1st February 2022 (Print 6, page 443) when it was agreed to recommend to this committee that the Council becomes a supporter of the National Park City Campaign, Councillor Richardson, City Convener for Sustainability and Carbon Reduction, presented a report, advising

- (1) that the concept of a National Park City was to inspire a shared vision for greener, healthier, and wilder cities where people, places and nature were better connected and a Glasgow National Park City campaign group had been formed and had made initial contact with Glasgow City Council as detailed at Appendix 1 of the report; and
- (2) of the aims of the Glasgow National Park City campaign group and the development of those aims, the application process, the links to existing Council strategy and workplace and the implications for the Council of endorsement to the National Park City foundation.

After consideration, the committee agreed to the Council becoming a supporter of the National Park City Campaign.
