Intelligent Street Lighting programme, phase 2 – Acceptance of funding approved.

- 4 Councillor Richardson, City Convener for Sustainability and Carbon Reduction, presented a report regarding the acceptance of funding to deliver phase 2 of the Intelligent Street Lighting (ISL) programme, advising
- (1) that following the implementation in the city centre of phase 1 of the ISL programme, it was recognised that ISL should be implemented city wide and a bid for funding from the European Regional Development Fund managed through the Scottish Government's 8th City Programme for phase 2 of the ISL programme had been successful;
- (2) of the objectives of phase 2 of the ISL programme; and
- (3) that the estimated cost for the delivery of phase 2 of the programme was £1,439,196 and 40% of the costs (£585,278) would be met from the funding from the European Regional Development Fund, with the remaining 60% being met from an existing capital allocation.

After consideration, the committee agreed to accept £585,278 of funding from the European Regional Development Fund.
