**Community Planning Partnership Governance Framework -

1. Background

- 1.1 The Area Partnership at its inaugural meeting, noted the Governance Framework for the revised Community Planning structures in Glasgow, including the composition of Area Partnerships which was confirmed as follows:
- (a) all elected members of Glasgow City Council from within the local electoral ward, one of whom shall chair the Partnership;
 - (b) no less than 4 and no more than 6 community residents from appropriate local community networks to be appointed in accordance with arrangements to be approved by the Strategic Board; and
 - (c) one member from each of the following Partners:-
 - Police Scotland
 - Scottish Fire & Rescue Service
 - NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde (Glasgow CHP)
- 1.2 The Area Partnership also considered how it would wish to fill vacant community residents positions and this report provides an update on that process as well as an amendment to the membership of Area Partnerships.

2. Area Partnerships - Community Representation

- 2.1 At the previous meeting, the Area Partnership noted that Parkhead Community Council and Dalrnarnock and Bridgeton Community Council had nominated representatives to become members and had taken their place on the Partnership.
- 2.2 The Area Partnership noted that representation would be sought from the following organisations to fill the current vacant positions:
- Calton Community Council
 - Camlachie Community Group
 - Gallowgate Transformational Regeneration Area Group
 - Reidvale Housing Association
- 2.3 Calton Community Council, Gallowgate Transformational Regeneration Area Group and Reidvale Housing Association have now complied with the qualifying criteria and have nominated representatives to take up their place on the Partnership.
- 2.4 Community representatives will be asked to provide a report to a future meeting of the Area Partnership outlining how they are engaging with their local communities.

3. Third Sector

- 3.1 As reported previously, the local Voluntary Sector Network led an election process to identify Third Sector representatives for the Area Partnerships, as well as the Senior Officers Groups and Sector Partnerships. An election process took place in July and representation from the Third Sector has now been secured.
