1. Background

1.1 The Area Partnership at its inaugural meeting, noted the Governance Framework for the revised Community Planning structures in Glasgow, including the composition of Area Partnerships which was confirmed as follows:

- (a) all elected members of Glasgow City Council from within the local electoral ward, one of whom shall chair the Partnership;
- (b) no less than 4 and no more than 6 community residents from appropriate local community networks to be appointed in accordance with arrangements to be approved by the Strategic Board; and
- (c) one member from each of the following Partners:-
 - Police Scotland
 - Scottish Fire & Rescue Service
 - NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde (Glasgow CHP)

1.2 The Area Partnership also considered how it would wish to fill vacant community residents positions and this report provides an update on that process as well as an amendment to the membership of Area Partnerships.

2. Scottish Fire and Rescue Service

2.1 At the previous meeting, the Area Partnership noted that William Lang had replaced Thomas Keay and Archie Curran had replaced Richard Norman as the representative and substitute respectively for Scottish Fire and Rescue Service.

3. Community Representation

3.1 The Area Partnership at their meeting on 1st May 2013 agreed that a nomination would be sought from Camlachie Community Group.

3.2 As a result of there being no nominated representative from the Camlachie Community Group to date, the Area Partnership may wish to identify a different community organisation in which to seek a nomination to fill the vacant community resident position.

4.1 At the previous meeting, the Area Partnership noted that the Third Sector Forum had nominated a substitute representative to become a member and she had taken her place on the Partnership.
