

## **PUBLIC PROCESSIONS COMMITTEE'S MINUTES.**

Glasgow, 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2014.

### **Appointment of Chair**

1 The committee agreed that Councillor Coleman be appointed to chair the meeting.

### **Consideration of representations in relation to public procession by West of Scotland Band Alliance on Sunday, 26th January 2014.**

2 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Corporate Services advising of considerations in relation to the proposed procession to be held by the West of Scotland Band Alliance on Sunday, 26th January 2014 and the failure to reach agreement on satisfactory arrangements to allow the procession to proceed resulting in the need for this committee to consider representations, in terms of the Police, Public Order and Criminal Justice (Scotland) Act 2006 and the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, as amended, in relation to the proposed route of the procession.

After having heard

- (1) M Thomson (for the Executive Director of Corporate Services), in further explanation of the report and who made representations regarding the risk to public safety, public order and disruption to the life of the community in relation to the proposed route of the procession submitted by the organisation;
- (2) R Glancy and C Patterson from the West of Scotland Band Alliance in support of the proposed route; and
- (3) Chief Inspector W Pettigrew, Police Scotland,

the committee agreed to impose an amended time and route for the procession to take place with assembly at 10.00 am and march-off at 10.30 am on the following route: Garnock Street, Royston Road, Castle Street, High Street, Glasgow Cross, Saltmarket, into Glasgow Green via the McLennan Arch where the procession would disperse.
