

Area Budget 2013/14 – Applications for funding dealt with.

8 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Corporate Services detailing applications for funding from the Calton Area Budget 2013/14.

After consideration, the Partnership

- (1) noted that, to date, £24,214 had been allocated to various projects in the Calton Ward, leaving a balance of £41,046; and
