

Update on Community Safety Glasgow services within the Calton Ward noted - Request to Managing Director of Community Safety Glasgow

4 There was submitted a report by the Managing Director, Community Safety Glasgow (CSG) regarding an update on the work of CSG within the Calton Ward, advising

- (1) of the Multi Agency Tasking and Coordinating process that had been established in conjunction with Police Scotland whose aim was to bring together community safety partners at a citywide level to work in partnership and deploy services to the areas most affected by crime and anti social behaviour;
- (2) of the various initiatives operating within the ward to tackle issues such as anti social behaviour and youth disorder;
- (3) of the priority planning process operating within the ward to allocate and prioritise resources based on a monthly operational assessment which identified issues under the CSG's 4 key priorities as detailed in the report; and
- (4) of the Community Safety Index for 2013/14 and priority areas within the Ward, as detailed in the report.

After consideration the Partnership

- (a) noted the report; and
- (b) requested the Managing Director of Community Safety Glasgow confirm the locations of CCTV cameras situated within the ward.
