

## Area Budget 2014/15 – Applications for funding dealt with.

5 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Corporate Services detailing applications for funding from the Calton Area Budget 2014/15.

After consideration, the Partnership

(1) noted

(a) in relation the grant applications continued at the Partnership meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2014 owing to the want of a quorum and given the support of members present at that meeting, awards had been made outwith the meeting cycle as follows:-

BDC Credit Union	Purchase of IT equipment	Awarded £6,000
People's Development Trust	To deliver a programme of activities for the community from 30th June to 12th August 2014	Awarded £6,000

(b) that to date, £32,087.50 had been allocated to various projects in the Calton Ward, leaving a balance of £33,172.50; and

(2) dealt with the applications for funding as follows, the grant awards being subject to the conditions detailed in the report:-
