

## CALTON AREA PARTNERSHIP ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ACTION PLAN

**Anti-Social Behaviour:** It is acting in a way that causes or is likely to cause alarm or distress to one or more people. To be anti-social, the behaviour must be persistent.
