

East Pollokshields Conservation Area – Appraisal and designation etc approved.

7 There was submitted a report by the Executive Director of Development and Regeneration Services regarding the outcome of a conservation area appraisal of the East Pollokshields area

- (1) advising that
 - (a) the conservation area appraisal programme had been established in 2002 and Glasgow currently had 23 designated conservation areas;
 - (b) the purpose of an appraisal was to identify and define what was important about the character and appearance of the area, and to assess the appropriateness of its boundaries; and
 - (c) following the preparation of a draft appraisal for East Pollokshields, public consultation had been carried out from April to May 2011; and
- (2) detailing the responses to the public consultation.

After consideration, the committee

- (i) noted the outcome of the appraisal; and
- (ii) approved
 - (A) the designation of the East Pollokshields Conservation Area;
 - (B) the conservation area appraisal as supplementary planning guidance; and
 - (C) the re-application for the confirmation of Article 4 directions for the areas subject to the proposed boundary changes.
